

Application for Mail-in Ballot

INFORMATION FOR THE ELECTOR:

An election for Chief Councillor, Deputy Chief Councillor and 3 Councillors of the Kwadacha Nation will be held on Tuesday, March 10, 2026.

If you wish to vote by mail-in ballot, you must complete this form and send it to the Electoral Officer by mail or e-mail. The information appears below.

You MUST INCLUDE A COPY of proof of identity, such as a copy of your Certificate of Indian Status, driver's license, health card, or other document that proves identify. DO NOT provide the original identification.

It is the elector's responsibility to request a mail-in ballot package with enough time to have a ballot package mailed to you and returned to the electoral officer by regular post on or before March 10, 2026. The Election Code requires requests by February 28, 2026, which may not allow enough time to return your ballot. Please make your requests ASAP.

* Note * Once you fill out this application and return it to the Electoral Officer, you will not be able to vote in person at the polling station unless you bring your mail-in ballots with you so that they may be voided. If you have lost your mail-in ballots, you must bring to the polling station a sworn affidavit stating that you have lost your mail-in ballots.
